Pathways Planning

Planning for career pathways is a critical part of secondary school. As a school we are planning to help prepare our students for their future, and this includes making smart choices about what to study in Year 11 onwards.

During Learning Advisory time this year students considered possible career pathways. Senior students have been involved in career conversations, and over the next week or so Year 10-12 students will be asked to consider what they would like to study next year to support their aspirations for the future. This is a very important time for students, and whanau, to reflect on their career/pathways goals and what subject choices they will need to make to support them with their pathways.

To help students make decisions around their studies we have planned a variety of events and resources including:

- 1. **Careers Workshop** We have organised for students to have the opportunity to talk individually with teachers about possible choices for next year. This will happen on Monday 30 October, during periods 4-6.
- 2. **Navigators Workshop** There will be a Navigating Pathways workshop on Wednesday 1 November from 6-7pm, in D Block, for Year 10, 11 and 12 students and whanau that wish to hear more about career planning and NCEA, and talk with former students and staff about possible options.
- 3. **Learning Advisory** Learning Advisors are talking with their groups and with individuals about their possible choices for next year.
- 4. **Course Booklet** Students, and whanau, will be provided with a course booklet which provides a brief outline of courses that may be running next year.
